

**Crochet pattern doll's top
(Size of the doll: about 40 cm)**



You'll need

- ♥ 25 g de DMC Natura Cotton
- ♥ Crochet hook size 3
- ♥ Fabric scrap to form a small bow
- ♥ Sewing thread
- ♥ Needle to weave in loose strands of yarn and to fix the bow

Abbreviations

Rnd	rounds
ch	crochet chain
dc	double crochet
sc	single crochet
sl st	slip stitch crochet

To start, make a crochet chain with 70 ch, close with a sl st.

Rnd 1 – 11: Start each rnd with 3 ch (they form the 1st dc of each rnd), then 1 dc in every stitch of the preceding rnd. At the end of each rnd, close with a sl st.

Rnd 12: 5 sl st, 3 ch, dc in each of the 28 next stitches, 16 ch, slip 8 stitches from the preceding rnd (to form the opening for the right arm), 1 sc, 3 ch, dc in each of the next 28 stitches, 16 ch, slip 8 stitches from the preceding rnds, 1 sc. This is the new end of the round, and you have now arrived at the front of the left arm opening.

Rnd 13: 3 ch, dc in each of the 28 next stitches, dc in each of the 16 next stitches of the crochet chain, dc in the 3rd ch which formed last row's 1st dc after the right arm's opening, dc in each of the next 28 stitches (you have now arrived at the end of the back of the top, we will now come to the crochet for the left arm opening), dc in each of the 15 next stitches of the crochet chain. Close the rnd with 1 sl st.

Rnd 14: 3 ch, 2 times 2 dc together (= 2 decreases), 20 dc, 2 times 2 dc together, 6 dc, 2 times 2 dc together, 5 dc, 2 times 2 dc together, 23 dc, 2 times 2 dc together, 3 dc, 2 times 2 dc together, 6 dc, 1 sl st.

Rnd 15: 3 ch, 3 times 2 dc together, 4 dc, 2 times 2 dc together, 5 dc, 3 times 2 dc together, 4 dc, 2 times 2 dc together, 4 dc, 3 times 2 dc together, 5 dc, 2 times 2 dc together, 5 dc, 3 times 2 dc together, 3 dc, 2 times 2 dc together, 5 dc, 1 sl st.

Rnd 16: 3 ch, 3 times 2 dc together, 1 dc, 3 times 2 dc together, 1 dc, 9 times 2 dc together, 1 dc, 3 times 2 dc together, 1 dc, 6 times 2 dc together, 2 dc, 1 sl st.

Rnd 17: 1 sc in each of the stitches, 1 sl st. Cut the yarn, leaving 6 cm of length.

Form a small bow with the scrap of yarn and fix it with the sewing thread on the upper left front of the top, near the shoulder. Weave in loose strands of yarn.
